ISO/IEC JTC 1/SC 27/WG 1 wishes to inform SC 7/WG 25 that Bridget Kenyon has been appointed as SC 27/WG 1 Editor for this project. Alain Bonneaud is acknowledged as the SC 7/WG 25 contributing editor. SC 27/WG 1 would like to express its appreciation for the nominations provided by SC 7/WG 25.

During the SC 27/WG 1 meetings held in Redmond from 2-6 November 2009, the first Working Draft for ISO/IEC 27013 was considered, with comments and contributions having been received from several National Bodies. All comments were successfully resolved. It was agreed to produce a second working draft with a focus on addressing areas where implementation of ISO/IEC 27001 and ISO/IEC 20000-1 can be more challenging due to gaps or perceived inconsistencies between the Standards. It was also agreed to issue a further call for contributions. SC 27/WG 1 will provide the second Working Draft text of ISO/IEC 27013 to SC 7/WG 25 when available.

To take into account the latest version of ISO/IEC 20000-1 in the drafting process, SC 27/WG 1 would appreciate the provision of updates on the revision status, and the Final Committee Draft, of ISO/IEC 20000-1. SC 27/WG 1 would also appreciate the provision of any other documents germane to the understanding or implementation of ISO/IEC 20000-1, such as implementation guidance documentation and ISO/IEC 20000-3.
