### 1. Expression of thanks.

SC 27/WG 3 thanks the CCDB for their Liaison Statement (SC 27 N 6128) as presented by the Liaison Officer at the Luzern, Switzerland, meeting, which has been considered very beneficial for the ongoing activity in the development of International Standards of SC 27/WG 3.

### 2. Progression of the SC 27/WG 3 projects.

### 3. Progression of work on IS 15408/IS 18045.

SC 27/WG 3 thanks the CCDB for the request of inputs for the further evolution of the security evaluation criteria.

To consolidate these inputs, an ad-hoc meeting has been called to address the long standing issues discussed at the SC 27/WG 3 meetings related to the capability to express security properties of a TOE, and its relationships between functional and assurance (e.g. design) requirements, and in particular to consider how to define a general framework for the definition and later evaluation of negative requirements, of which the lack of vulnerabilities already deserves a fundamental attention in IS 15408.
